

Act it Out

Instructions:

Act out the protections and ideas found in the Bill of Rights! See below for a possible setup of this activity.

Step 1: Split the class into small groups.

Step 2: Give each group a set of cards (cut out).

Step 3: One student pulls a card at random and acts out the concept (no sounds allowed).

Step 4: The other students in the group guess the concept.

Step 5: If the correct concept is guessed within one minute, the group gets one point.

Step 6: After all are acted out, determine which amendment(s) each concept belongs to.
